

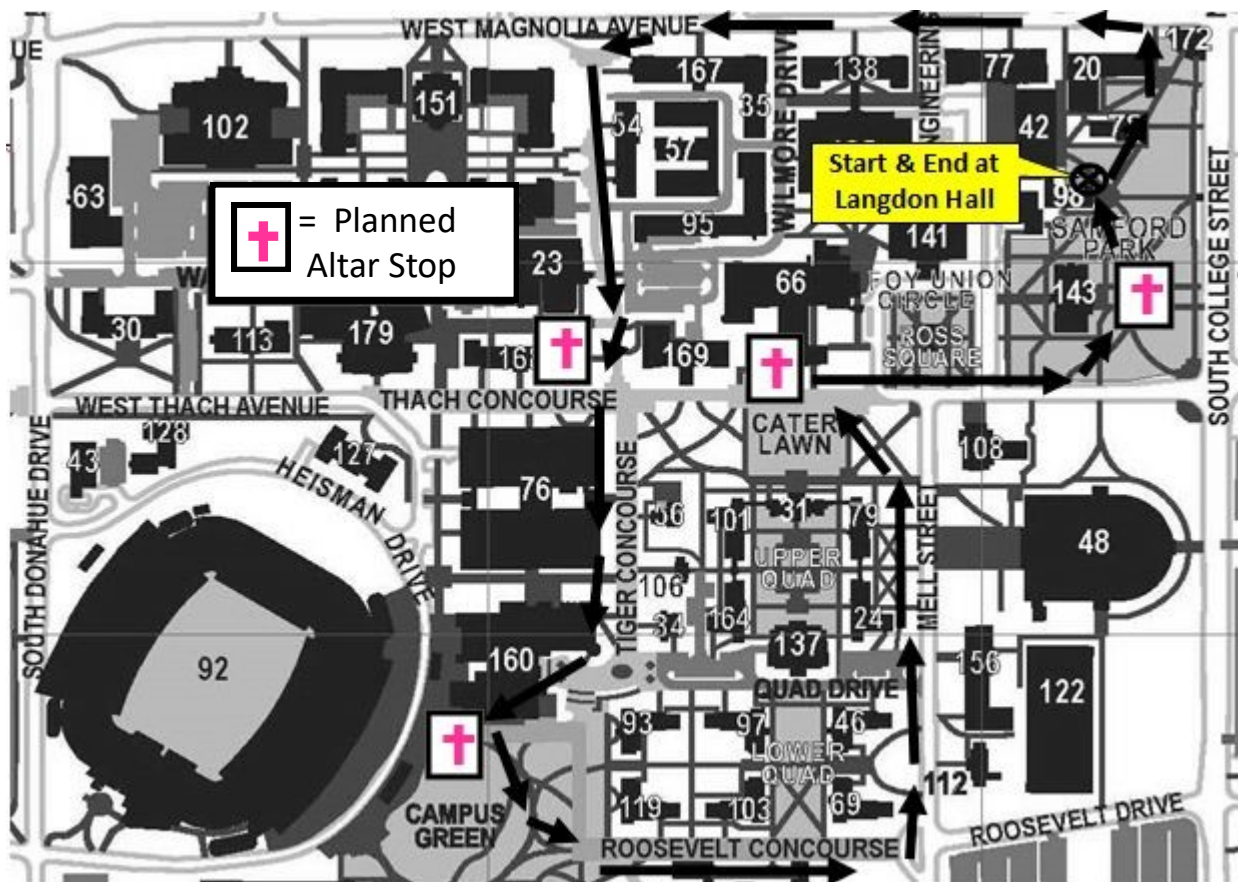
St. Michael's 6th Annual Eucharistic Procession

Monday, October 22, 2018, 7 – 8:30 p.m.

The procession will begin and end at Langdon Hall located just north of Samford Hall on College Street. Parking is available in the Library parking deck.

A Eucharistic procession is a public ceremony where the Eucharist is carried in a monstrance for all to see. Candles and incense accompany the Blessed Sacrament, and are followed by the faithful carrying candles. Prayers and songs accompany the procession, which will stop briefly at various places on campus, then return to Langdon Hall for a final Benediction.

Come and be a witness to the Catholic faith in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist as we pray for ourselves, our parish, our city, nation and world. You can join us at any point along the processional route.
